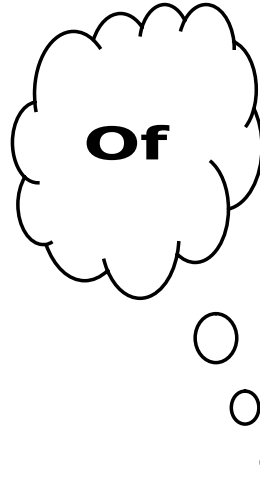

RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
